EDITORIAL

For some issues now the Editorial has been focussed on BCF affairs but with present developments I feel it is time to look closer to home in an effort to put our own house in order. For many years Yorkshire chess has been dominated by stalwarts of the YCA such as Geoff Sunderland, Alan Slomson and the late Dr Addingley. However, the time eventually arrives when replacements have to be found for these great servants on the YCA.

Unfortunately for Yorkshire the last four years has seen many of its long standing organisers relinquishing their posts and as usual replacements have been hard to find. As most members will be aware Alan Slomson has decided that his long commitment to Yorkshire Chess as Treasurer has to come to an end at the end of this current season.

It is of the utmost importance therefore that a successor be found before the AGM in June as the Association cannot continue to operate without a Treasurer and Alan has given the Association a full 12 months notice of his intention not to stand for the post. I have to report that at present our efforts to replace Alan have met with no success.

Most YCA members have enjoyed the facilities supplied by the YCA organsiation but if this is to continue more members must be prepared to offer administrative assistance. Although the post of Treasurer is the most pressing there are other areas of concern. Simon Deighton has, because of business pressures, decided not to seek re-election as Tournament Controller. It is hoped that a successor for this post will be found, however it may be that this post will be returned to the Secretary as in previous years.

Finally, it must be pointed out that because of the recent illness of Geoff Sunderland (reported inside) the Bulletin has been deprived of a joint-editor for this issue therefore much of the input has had to come from myself. It is hoped that Geoff will be back to full health soon and that all the membership will make some effort to contribute information for publication as there are many areas of Yorkshire chess that at present are not submitted.

NCCU/BCF

Since publication of the last bulletin there have been two meetings of the NCCU and although many of the matters discussed did not affect Yorkshire the items are listed for information. In the past there have been problems in arranging venues in the second stages of the NCCU County Championships as the rules state that they should be played on a neutral venue. In order to avoid the difficulties of the past Bradford has been designated as the venue for matches between the North East and the West though Lancashire/Durham have agreed to play at Harrogate and Cumbria (for obvious reasons) are exempt, (this of course does not apply to Yorkshire also).

The NCCU Club Championship has also run into venue difficulties, it has been decided that this should also be staged as centrally as possible on a permanent basis and a venue has been arranged at Ossett Town Hall. Unfortunately for Yorkshire the date of April 7 is also a Yorkshire league date, so unless suitable arrangements can be made it would appear that Yorkshire will be unrepresented.

Rochdale had hoped to stage this years Glorney/Faber Cups, however due to sponsorship difficulties this is now not possible.

Durham nominated Carr Hill Primary school for the BCET award and this was accepted as was Merseysides' nomination of St Benet's Primary shool for the NCCU Shield.

The NCCU considered offering a venue for a future British Lightning Championship tournament, however it appears that York has already approached the BCF on this matter, perhaps more information on this will be forthcoming in the near future.

When the meeting came to consider BCF affairs it soon became obvious that so much correspondence etc. has to be dealt with that a special meeting would be desirable and this was duly held on March 10. One of the first items to be dealt with concerned Junior selection and the structure of the BCF selection committee. It was noted that there was a vacancy on the committee and in view of the sparse representation from the North the meeting nominated Jeff Horner for this position. A long discussion followed on various proposals from various directors of the BCF some of which met with general approval whilst others were not and interestingly enough there seems to be a movement within the NCCU away from the policy of payment for grading and league affiliation schemes that have been vigorously fought by the YCA. The BCF are continuing to work towards centralised grading by computer and it is envisaged that eventually the BCF will only require basic results to be forwarded for grading and they will perform the mathematical contribution. Of course they will only be prepared to grade (or publish) their members which to me seems a reasonable approach. It remains to be seen how this will operate and to what extent local organsiations will contribute and as usual much will depend on the approach made by the BCF. The NCCU policy on these matters,

will, if adopted, revolutionise the structure of the BCF and their relationship with grass roots players. The NCCU is to propose that the BCF adopt a system similar to the American one and incorporate Newsflash and BCM into one edition, as an appendix possibly, and to include this in the subscription. In other words all BCF members will receive a monthly magazine (BCM could be produced as at present for subscribers who were not BCF members).

If this is coupled with a computerised grading system it may also be possible to include a regularly updated grade each month as well as other special offers that may be available. It is suggested that such a scheme would involve the average player with the BCF activities, would give the BCF and its members more direct contact with each other, would relieve the Secretary of many duties so enabling him to concentrate more fully on the administration of the BCF's affairs and increase the circulation of the BCM so helping to maintain or reduce costs and attract advertisers. Of course, such a policy couldn't be implemented overnight as there are many implications to be considered but it was the NCCU view that such a policy could dramatically improve both the status and financial position of the BCF.

The NCCU also discussed the present budget of the BCF and the amount spent on Home Chess which was generally thought to be inadequate when compared to other areas. It was suggested that the BCF undertook to arrange venues for the final stages of the Counties Championships and that they also undertake to give substantial financial assistance to these matches. either in the form of the Hire Charges or reinstate travel grants and that in appointing venues that they should match the stature desired of finals of a national competition. The BCF have mooted the idea of a national league and the NCCU gave general approval to this instead but conceeded that a sponsor would probably be required to assist in the funding.

Some discussion took place on the use of computers both in postal and OTB chess. The feeling of the meeting seemed to indicate that they offered some threat to postal chess and that the BCF should discourage their use in postal competitions. They also felt that no pllyer should be forced to play a computer either in congress of league chess.

As can be seen from these items there were many items discussed in this meeting. Talk lasted a total of some $8\frac{1}{2}$ hours and as the last meeting was in fact only a few days ago much of the information is from notes and memory and as ar as I know this covers the major points of the meeting. Hower, other issues were discussed like changes in the BCF administration structure, but I would prefer to await the Minutes of the meeting before commenting further.

Finally, the BCF have indicated that there should be a move away from adjudications and a suggestion that adjudicated games should not be eligible for grading as they don't reflect a players strength. Adjudications have been unpopular for many years in some quarters and in others seen as the lesser of two evils (the other being fast finishes).

Although I cannot agree that adjudications should not be graded I do sympathise with the sentiments that adjudication should be kept to a minimum. The time control introduced by the BCF for the final stages of the Counties Championship has some merit and could be modified and adopted in local leagues. A possible suggestion being 36 moves per 1.1/4 hrs then clocks retarded 15 minutes and an additional 14 moves played in the time remaining which seems a reasonable compromise between adjudication and rapid finishes and should reduce the numbers of adjudications.

In the Yorkshire league there seems less need for such measure at present, however, it must be noted that adjudications appear to be increasing, no doubt more will be heard on this subject.

I trust that all members will feel free to forward views on these matters.

SEASON '84/'85

As most members will be aware the bulletin over the last few issues has not appeared with the normal regularity and in addition many clubs were less than happy at the date of publication of the YCA Diary. In the case of the bulletin some explanations have been forwarded. However, the membership themselves can help matters. In particular it should be remembered that team results have to be duplicated and to say the least some of the legibility of results leaves something to be desired. Team captains can hardly complain if unfamiliar names appear on the team results when the correct name cannot de deciphered and in addition the published results are used for grading so team captains owe it to their players to ensure that all results are clearly readable.

When I became Secretary one of my first duties was to compile the YCA Diary. However, I soon found how difficult such a simple task was. Firstly, much of the information needed was not forwarded by Clubs and secondly many Clubs themselves were unaware of who their official were to be and who the team captains would be as many of the AGM's were yet to take place.

The situation concerning the Diary for 1984 is this ALL information has to be WITH THE SECRETARY no later than June 30. This includes all Club officials for the coming season, venues etc. so it is up to the Clubs to ensure that these details are taken car of so as to meet the deadline. The Diary for 1984 must be circulated in August hopefully with all the information needed. Club Secretary's have now been given sufficient notice that the deadline for material will be June 30 and any details not available by that date unfortunately cannot be included in the Diary. It will be unfortunate if your Club officials are not entered but we must produce the Diary earlier than two weeks before the start of the season so as to enable Clubs to book their venues
