#### RULES:

- All tournaments will be five rounds Swiss, and all entrants will be expected to play each round. Players may claim a half-point bye for any one round at the time of entry.
- The ECF Jan 2025 ratings will be used to determine eligibility for rating-restricted sections. The Feb 2025 ratings will be used for pairings and rating-prize purposes. Players entering before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2025 will be moved up a section(s) if their Jan 2025 rating is above the upper limit for the section they originally entered.
- Unrated players must give an indication of their playing strength where possible at the time of entry (e.g. recent congress results). Unrated players will not be eligible for rating prizes unless they provide acceptable evidence of their playing strength. Organisers reserve the right to transfer any entrant from one tournament to another.
- Phones are allowed in the venue but must be switched off during play. Phones and other electronic devices should not be on one's person while a game is in progress. Anyone wearing an electronic device for medical reasons should inform the arbiters before play.
- The default time will be 30 minutes after the start of the round. A player may be re-paired if their opponent defaults.
- No smoking is allowed inside the school building or in the grounds.
- In all matters the organisers' decision is final. The organisers exercise their right to reduce the prize fund in the event of insufficient entries.

### RATE OF PLAY (now with increments)

The time each player will have to complete the game will be 1 hour and 40 minutes with a 10-second increment added after each move from move 1.

### SAFEGUARDING

To comply with the school's safeguarding policy, all competitors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
